 - The number of years of post-secondary study you will have completed by April 2019 and the program of study in which you are enrolled;
 - Applicants must be returning to full-time studies in the fall of 2019;
 - Your fluency in the use of both official languages (English and French);
3. Submit an updated version of your résumé and cover letter;

5. The subject line of your email must contain the reference number and position title to which you are applying;
6. Applicants must be returning to full-time studies in the fall of 2019.
