The Lead Camp Counsellor assists in camp program development and trains Camp Counsellors on the various STEAM (Science, technology, engineering, art, mathematics) activities using creativity and strong leadership skills. The Lead Camp Counsellor assists in the coordination and daily preparation of camps, delivers camp programs alongside Camp Counsellors, and performs other camp duties.
