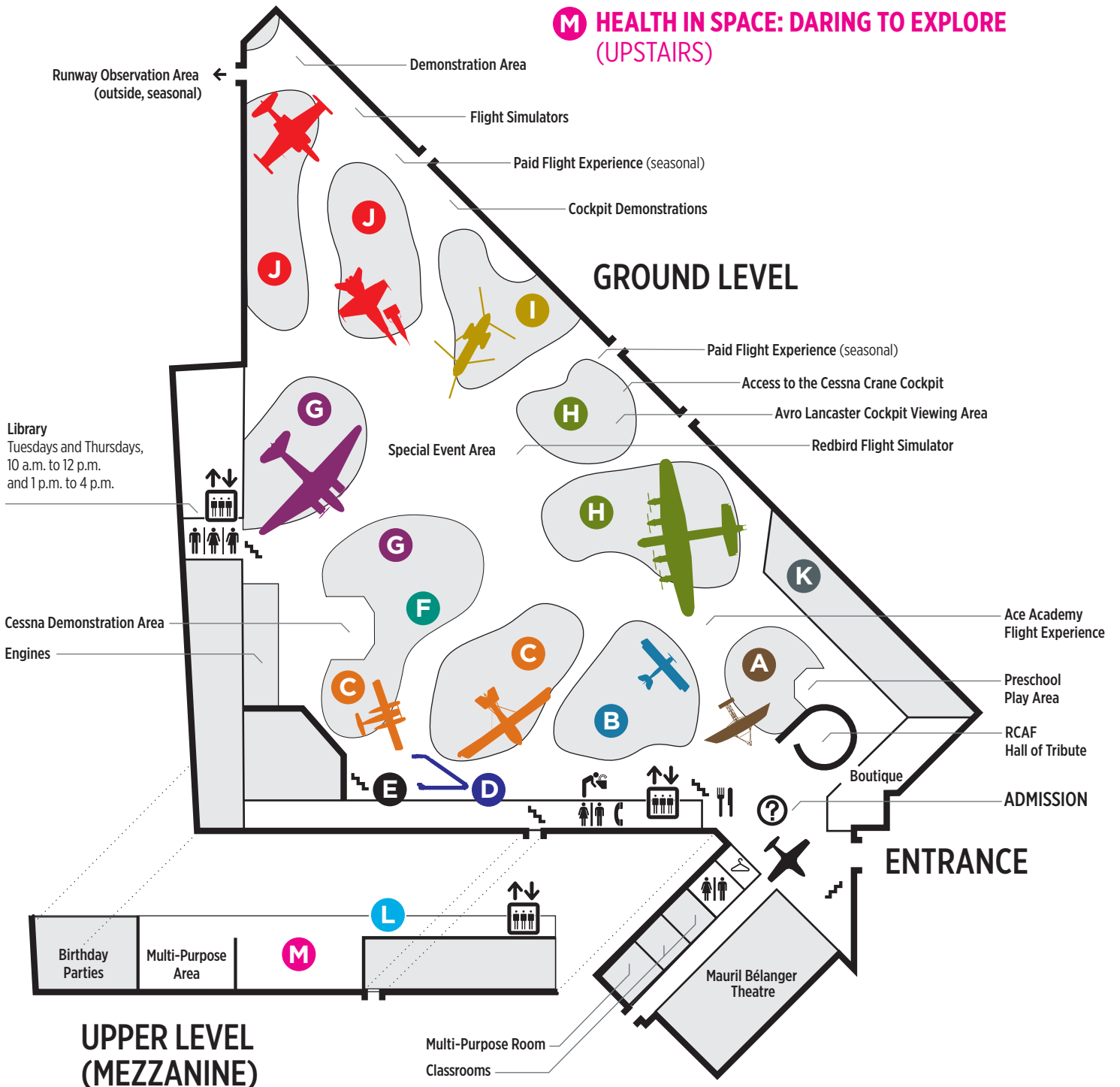
McDonnell Douglas CF-18 — One of the best jet fighters of the late twentieth century
