Ice Cream Cone Handprint Craft



Materials

White paper
Paint brush
Non-toxic, washable paint, various colours
Non-toxic, washable markers, various colours

Method



Draw an upside down triangle in the middle of the paper. This is your ice cream cone.



Using a paintbrush, paint one of your hands with the non-toxic paint. Place your palm onto the white paper, at the top of your cone with your fingers aiming down. This is the ice cream.
Repeat as many times as you like to create many 'scoops' of ice cream.

Paint one of your thumbs red. Place your thumbprint at the top of the ice cream cone. This is the cherry at the top of your cone.

Once fully dried, enjoy your delicious summer masterpiece!
