An educator will bring your group to a classroom at the start of your program.

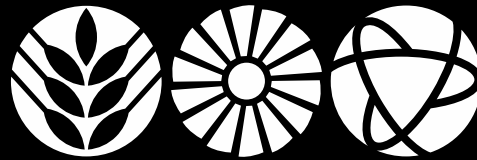
Here is where most of the activities take place.
